# Morphed by Tero Saarinen Company (Finland)

October 27 & 28, 2017, 8pm Vancouver Playhouse, 600 Hamilton Street

VANCOUVER, BC / 19 September 2017 — In the spirit of Finland's centennial, DanceHouse is pleased to kick off its 10<sup>th</sup> anniversary season with the Vancouver debut of celebrated Finnish troupe **Tero Saarinen Company**.

Led by dancer-choreographer Tero Saarinen, the company will perform Morphed, an evening length work for seven male dancers. Hailed as a masterpiece of opposing forces and frictions, Saarinen's choreography tackles themes of change and sensuality in a fresh exploration of masculinity.

Recognized for his multidimensional artistry, Saarinen does not disappoint with Morphed, which brings together powerful movement, stunning visual landscapes and a bold score. Mikki Kunttu's sets highlight a world constantly on tilt, as the dancers tangle and navigate through a forest of dancing ropes surrounding the stage. The work is performed to three pieces by acclaimed orchestra conductor and composer Esa-Pekka Salonen— Concert étude for solo horn (2000), Foreign Bodies (2001), and Violin Concerto (2009)—each notable for its kinetic quality and innate musical duality. Saarinen's choreography further expands on these existing musical themes, submerging the audience in a striking world of sensitivity, heroism and all that lies between.
